## Re: Town of Medley Bulk Trash Collection Regulations

Dear Town of Medley Residents:

As you place your bulk trash out for collection, keep in mind the following:

- Bulk trash is picked up twice a month. Please refer to the schedule before placing any trash out for collection;
- Trash piles cannot be placed out more than 2 days (48 hours) before the scheduled pickup day;
- Without blocking the street, sidewalk or alley, place your bulk trash as far as possible from fencing, utility poles, meters, vehicles and your garbage can. The Town of Medley is not responsible for property damage resulting from improper trash placement;
- Code compliance officer regularly monitor Town streets for violations. If a trash pile is set out illegally, the resident will be served with a Notice of Violation. If the problem is not corrected, the resident will be served with a Failure to Comply notice;
- Any broken glass must be placed in a box and taped closed to prevent injuries to workers picking up bulk items;
- All household appliances must have doors removed (washing machines, dryers, refrigerators etc...)

The following items are not acceptable and <u>WILL NOT</u> be picked up. It is the homeowner's responsibility to dispose of these items properly. <u>DO NOT</u> place these materials for pickup at any time. See the Special Collection information below.

- Construction and remodeling debris
- Toxic Materials
- Paint Cans
- Tires
- Auto Parts
- Tree Limbs more than six feet long
- Explosives and highly flammable materials
- Hazardous waste
- Dead animals
- Propane tanks

## **Special Collection Information**

Construction and Remodeling Debris—The property owner must dispose of construction materials. Call the Miami-Dade County Department of Solid Waste Management for additional information. If a landscape or construction contractor is working on your property, then the contractor is responsible for disposing of the materials.

For Oil Product Disposal- Call the Florida Department of Environmental Services at (800)-741-4337.

To Dispose of Household Chemicals and Paint Products- Call Miami-Dade County at 3-1-1.

Once the bulk trash has been collected, you **CAN NOT** place any additional bulk trash at curbside.
