
**ADDENDUM No. 3:
TOWN OF MEDLEY BID No. 2011-07**

**PAVING AND DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS FLOOD MITIGATION AREA
JANUARY 18, 2012**

This Addendum forms a part of the Bidding Documents and will be incorporated into the Contract Documents. Insofar as the Invitation for Bid or Drawings or both are inconsistent, this Addendum governs. The Invitation for Bid (IFB) is revised to the extent specifically amended by this Addendum. Otherwise, all provisions of the IFB remain in effect.

The addendum will hereby modify, correct, and/or supplement the contract documents as follows:

3-1: INVITATION TO BID: Section 1-32: Summary of Documents to be submitted by Bidders:

- Remove the existing Bid Table and add the revised Bid table (See Attachment 3-1):
The changes can be tracked with the following color coding:
 - Green – New Items
 - Red – Removed Items
 - Orange – Quantity revised

3-2: BIDDERS QUESTIONS: All bidding contractors questions submitted to the Town of Medley's website can be found in the attached document (Attachment 3-2) with the questions response.

3-3: SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Event number 3 – Opening of Bids

- Change date to January 31st, 2012
 - Bids are due by 3:00 pm. Bid opening at 3:01 pm.

3-4: GENERAL CONDITIONS: Section VI – Contractor's Responsibilities. 2. Resident Superintendent:

- This paragraph now reads:
 - 2. Resident Superintendent: Contractor shall keep on the worksite ~~at all times~~ a competent superintendent and any necessary assistants who shall not be replaced without written notice to the Town and Engineer unless the superintendent proves to be unsatisfactory to Contractor and ceases to be in its employ. The superintendent will be Contractor's representative at the site and shall have authority to act on behalf of Contractor. All communications given to the superintendent shall be as binding as if given to Contractor.
- This paragraph shall now read:
 - 2. Superintendent: Contractor shall keep on the worksite a competent superintendent and any necessary assistants who shall not be replaced

without written notice to the Town and Engineer unless the superintendent proves to be unsatisfactory to Contractor and ceases to be in its employ. The superintendent will be Contractor's representative at the site and shall have authority to act on behalf of Contractor. All communications given to the superintendent shall be as binding as if given to Contractor.

3-5: CLARIFICATION ON REVISED BID TABLE: Item #13 – 8" Thick Slab on Grade Include Finish but not Forms

- This item shall include the cost of any special provisions required/associated with the Maintenance of Traffic during construction of this intersection

REMINDER: Bidders must mark "Addendum No. 3" on the Addendum Conformance Form and sign and return the form with your Bid package. Failure to do so may result in the disqualification of you Bid.
