ATTENTION: "All Medley Residents":

Hurricane season is upon us once again. Mobile Home and Manufactured Building residents <u>MUST</u> evacuate for all hurricanes. When a hurricane is a threat to the residents of Medley, an Evacuation Order will be issued by Miami-Dade County. This Evacuation Order may be issued 24-48 hours before the hurricane is forecast to make landfall. An early evacuation is REQUIRED due to the large number of residents to be evacuated in Miami-Dade County and the requirement that the evacuation must be completed before the wind reaches 40 miles per hour. When a hurricane is several days away, review your evacuation plan to make sure it is still current. When an Evacuation Order is issued (or before), you <u>MUST:</u>

Secure your residence from damage in the event the storm hits. Town employees will try to assist you in lowering window awnings <u>ONLY</u>. Disabled residents will be assisted first. Please remember, disabled persons, persons requiring special assistance, and persons with pets <u>MUST re-register with the "Emergency Evacuation Assistance Program"</u>. YOU CANNOT STAY IN A MOBILE HOME. When leaving your mobile home it is recommended you take the following.

Prescription Medicines
Flashlight & Batteries
Dietary Supplements
Blankets, pillows, change of clothes
Identification/Valuable papers
Toiletries
