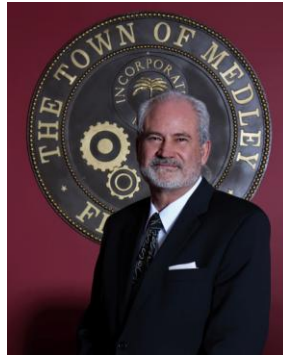


ROBERTO MARTELL
